Happy Lunar New Year to all the members of the parish and visitors. May the Lord Bless you this Year of the Pig.

Pope Francis has a warm devotion to the Mother of God. It is an intimate relationship like that of mother and son rather than queen and subject. Before and after every trip, the Pope visits the image of Maria, Salus Populi Romani, Mary, Health/Salvation of the Roman People, in the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore; he places everything in her care. He will



comment frequently on images or statues of the Virgin and touch them. One New Year's Day he said, 'Devotion to Mary is not spiritual etiquette; it is a requirement of the Christian life. The gift of the Mother, the gift of every mother and every woman, is most precious for the Church, for she too is mother and woman. If our faith is not to be reduced merely to an idea or a doctrine, all of us need a mother's heart, one which knows how to keep the tender love of God and to feel the heartbeat of all around us.'

Devotion to Mary helps prevent our worship, our faith becoming hardened; we learn from her that truth is always joined to love. We learn from her the importance of pondering on situations with which we struggle not just with our minds, but prayerfully in our hearts. She invites us not to close our hearts, but hand over everything to God and dwell on it WITH HIM. So often we try to solve our problems by ourselves, but God is intimately concerned with everything in our lives and Mary invites to keep bringing everything to him with trust in his tenderness. So when struggling with something big or small, why not pay a visit to the Cathedral's lovely Ladychapel or come to the Novena on Wednesday, and ponder on it with Mary. She always takes us to the Son she loved so faithfully and continues to love for ever.
