RECONCILIATION - *"Everyone say to himself: 'When was the last time I went to confession?' And if it has been a long time, don't lose another day! Go, the priest will be good. And Jesus, (will be) there, and Jesus is better than the priests - Jesus receives you. He will receive you with so much love! Be courageous and go to confession."* This was the Pope's exhortation at a Wednesday audience. Take a look at the regular confession times on the page opposite. Come along to the Second Rite of Reconciliation - individual confession within a liturgical service - which will be celebrated at the Cathedral on Friday, 5 April at 6pm.

VOLUNTARY ASSISTED DEATH LEGISLATION (VAD) - Over the next few months our state parliamentarians are going to be debating and voting on VAD Legislation. This vote is not a foregone conclusion as the press would have us believe. As well as the moral issues surrounding this legislation there are very real practical issues which have failed to be addressed and which are causing problems where this type of legislation has been passed and put into practice. The Cathedral parish is looking for a volunteer who can act as coordinator in getting the message to our Members of Parliament that there is a strong voice against this legislation. The coordinators role would be to coordinate a network of people to systematically contact our elected members over the period where decisions are being formed and made. The parish will support you in this very important work. The time for action on this is now as the legislation will come before parliament this year.
