**DEAN'S BIT** – Last week at the Sunday 11am Mass the Archbishop, who was the main celebrant, spoke very movingly of the Christchurch attack. He reminded us of a fundamental truth that we are all children of the Creator and so, whatever our religion, we are all brothers and sisters. We prayed at the Mass for our Muslim brothers and sisters. The Archbishop also spoke of the fear which Muslim communities all over, including in Perth, must be feeling. Some of us have attended an impromptu vigil in the city and a memorial service at the Perth mosque. The events of the last week call us to remember the love for all people which is at the heart of our Christian discipleship. It calls us to build bridges and to be welcoming of the people of different faiths and origins who make up our society. Pope Francis and Ahmed el-Tayeb, Grand Imam of al-Azhar signed a joint statement in February. Their aspiration is that the declaration *'may be a witness to the greatness of faith in God that unites divided hearts and elevates the human soul; [and] may be a sign of the closeness between East and West, between North and South, and between all who believe that God has created us to understand one another, cooperate with one another and live as brothers and sisters who love one another.'* Let us work to make it a reality.
