DEAN'S BIT-


ASH WEDNESDAY AND LENT - This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday which marks the beginning of the season of Lent. There is Mass with the imposition of ashes at the Cathedral at 8am, 12.10pm and 6pm; and at All Saints Chapel at 12.10pm. Ash Wednesday is a day of abstinence and fasting. Abstinence in Catholic practice is to refrain from eating meat. Fasting means having only one full meal on a day. Smaller quantities of food may be eaten at two other meals but no food should be consumed at any other time during the day. The law of fasting applies to people from 18 to 59 years old. Everyone aged 14 years and older is bound by the law of abstinence from meat. The Stations of the Cross are celebrated in the Cathedral every Friday of Lent at 5.30pm. The Second Rite of Reconciliation - individual confession within a liturgical service - will be celebrated at the Cathedral on 5 April at 6pm.

SACRAMENTS FOR SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN - In the Archdiocese of Perth, the sacrament program is a familyfocused, parish-based, school and Parish Religious Education Program supported approach to the preparation and celebration of the sacraments. Each parish runs a sacrament program, but the first place of formation in faith is the family. The family is supported by the Catholic school or by the parish's catechism classes or PREP. A child will need to attend PREP from year two if they are not attending a Catholic school. First Reconciliation or Penance is celebrated in Year Three. First Communion is received in Year Four. Confirmation is received in Year Six. The enrolment for the Cathedral sacrament program has taken place. If you have not enrolled please speak to the one of the priests or contact the parish office.

VOLUNTARY ASSISTED DEATH LEGISLATION (VAD) - Over the next few months our state parliamentarians are going to be debating and voting on VAD Legislation. This vote is not a foregone conclusion as the press would have us believe. As well as the moral issues surrounding this legislation there are very real practical issues which have failed to be addressed and which are causing problems where this type of legislation has been passed and put into practice. The Cathedral parish is looking for a volunteer who can act as coordinator in getting the message to our Members of Parliament that there is a strong voice against this legislation. The coordinators role would be to coordinate a network of people to systematically contact our elected members over the period where decisions are being formed and made. The parish will support you in this very important work. The time for action on this is now as the legislation will come before parliament this year.
