An especially happy feast day to our parishioners being confirmed today! Congratulations to you and your families.

We are a people born of water and the Spirit in baptism, sealed with the Spirit at confirmation, fed through the power of the Spirit at Mass. We name the Spirit whenever we make the sign of the Cross. The priest calls on the Spirit during the Eucharistic Prayer at Mass. In the Western Church there is not the tradition of invoking the Spirit in every day prayer. Pope Francis has been encouraging us to pray to the Spirit, to bring everything to him. I find when I pray to the Spirit about an issue, a discussion, a problem, the Spirit helps settle things within me and opens me up to approaching the issue with deeper trust. The Spirit enables us to move the focus away from ourselves to God's Kingdom.

I reflect often on the words of Pope Francis:

'You too need to see the entirety of your life as a mission. Try to do so by listening to God in prayer and recognizing the signs that he gives you. Always ask the Spirit what Jesus expects from you at every moment of your life and in every decision you must make, so as to discern its place in the mission you have received. Allow the Spirit to forge in you the personal mystery that can reflect Jesus Christ in today's world.

May you come to realize what that word is, the message of Jesus that God wants to speak to the world by your life. Let yourself be transformed. Let yourself be renewed by the Spirit, so that this can happen, lest you fail in your precious mission. The Lord will bring it to fulfilment despite your mistakes and missteps, provided that you do not abandon the path of love but remain ever open to his supernatural grace, which purifies and enlightens.' (Gaudete et Exsultate, 23, 24)

The Lord is so generous in his love that he wants each of us to reflect something of his mystery, to be his coworkers, friends in bringing about the Kingdom. May the Spirit lead us to express the mystery of Jesus in a unique way through our life.

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.
