**THE BASQUE PILGRIM** - On Wednesday we celebrated the feast of St Ignatius Loyola. It was his Spiritual Exercises which was the basis of my retreat in July. Here is a little bit on Ignatius by Fr Chris Jenkins SJ and used with his permission. *Inigo Lopez de Loyola, St Ignatius Loyola (1491-1556) grew up in the Basque region of northern Spain, a nobleman and soldier of the king. A complex, driven young man with little formal religious instruction, he was wounded by a cannonball on the ramparts of Pamplona. During a long and painful convalescence, he experienced a major conversation, followed by a period of "spiritual pilgrimage", which led many years later to the founding of the Society of Jesus, the Jesuits. Ignatius' experiences of finding God alive in himself, others, creation and history is captured in his Spiritual Exercises. They are a record of one man's journey into the mystery of salvation, a record which had resonated with the lives and experience of many others over the centuries. Ignatius believed that the movements of the Spirit are recognisable in everyone's experience, discerned and acted upon in prayer, decision-making and daily living. The Ignatian tradition is Christ-centred and world-affirming; it embraces change as the theatre of the Spirit and is available to all.*
