**DEAN'S BIT** - 'Pray, brothers and sisters, that my sacrifice and yours' is the invitation to join in the great prayer of thanksgiving through Jesus. 'My sacrifice and yours' may give the impression that the priest's sacrifice is somehow different from everyone else's, but this is not the case. The latin word used to join 'my' and 'yours' is a little one, 'ac', but it is stronger than the English 'and'. It is used to 'connect words or thoughts which form a whole' (Lewis). So 'our sacrifice' probably conveys the meaning better which is somewhat ironic because that was the wording of the pre-2011. 'My sacrifice which is likewise yours' would also convey the meaning better. We are all participating in the one great sacrifice of praise to the Father. In the Mass there is no first and second class; there is the one People of God whom Christ joyfully gathers around him. We may have different roles in the Mass, but the Mass does not belong more to the priest than anyone else. We all come with our intentions, our prayers, our thanksgiving and at the Mass we join it to the great prayer of Christ our High Priest. You are not passive while the priest is active at Mass. We are all active participants in different ways. We are all by our baptism one priestly people and one of the ways we exercise our priesthood is bringing all our concerns, hopes, joys to the Mass and giving it to God our Father through his beloved Son. Do so with faith and confidence.
