**DEAN'S BIT** - 24 September is Mercy Day. The Sisters of the Mercy and the schools which they established have been celebrating over the past week. The Mercy Sisters have contributed a great deal to the church in Perth. Mercedes College, next door to us, and founded in 1846 is the first school in Australia to be founded by a religious congregation and Western Australia's first permanent school still on its original site. Mother Ursula Frayne led a small group of sisters out to the distant colony. The Sisters were still a very young congregation, but they responded to the request for help with faith-filled generosity. They arrived here and were greeted by no one! Bishop Brady had told them of large numbers of students waiting on them, but only one turned up at the beginning of the first day of school. The sisters could easily have packed it in and returned to Dublin, but they stayed, and we owe them and the sisters who followed them a great debt of gratitude. We would be much diminished as a church without the witness and ministry of the Sisters of Mercy and so many other religious who have laboured in the Lord's vineyard. Why not make contact with any Sisters of Mercy you know to thank them? At the very least, say a prayer thanking God for them and asking him to bless them and their works.
