PLENARY COUNCIL PHASE 2 - Plenary Council Phase 2. Thank you to everyone who participated in the first phase. The second phase of our journey to the Plenary Council, building on the first, is a listening and discernment phase. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to participate. This is a group process of prayer and sharing with one another and seeking God's direction around the themes of the first phase. As the Holy Spirit guides the Church in Australia, all are welcome to participate and discern together. The process is a guided one and does not require a degree in spirituality or theology! It does require time and the meeting for this phase lasts around two-and-a-half hours (2.5hrs). Each parish group is asked to produce a 150-word response which will go to the national group. The Cathedral will hold its gathering in late February 2020. We would like to know whether you would prefer a Wednesday evening (6.30pm - 9pm) or Saturday morning (9.30am - noon) session.
