FIRST COMMUNION – The First Communion Commitment and Enrolment Mass will be on Saturday, 8 August at 6pm. The parent-child workshop will be held in the parish centre on Wednesday, 19 August at 5.30pm. And the First Communion Mass will be on Sunday, 30 August at 11am. Please take note of the dates.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS – The developing situation in Victoria and New South Wales makes us all aware of the importance of continuing to observe health guidelines including the regular cleansing of hands and the physical-distance recommendation. The holy water stoups will remain empty and Communion will only be offered under one kind. Surfaces in the Cathedral are regularly treated with a non-toxic antimicrobial compound which is TGA approved. Please take your parish bulletin home with you and dispose of any leaflets in the bins provided (the bulletin and leaflets may not be reused). The Archbishop's directives contain the following: *In view of the now long-standing practice of receiving Holy Communion in the hand, all Catholics receiving Holy Communion at Masses celebrated in the Ordinary Form of the Roman Rite are very strongly encouraged, out of concern for the health of others including the celebrant and other ministers, to refrain from receiving Holy Communion on the tongue.* If you are unable to receive on the hand, you are asked to wait till the end of Communion and to come to the priest.

Finally, *persons who feel unwell, who have flu/respiratory symptoms, elevated body temperatures or who have been in contact in the previous fourteen (14) days with persons suspected to have, or who have been diagnosed with COVID-19, are not permitted to enter churches or chapels.*
