**DEAN'S BIT** – Do we not recognise all too readily this truth enunciated by Pope Francis in *Fratelli Tutti*: 'The best way to dominate and gain control over people is to spread despair and discouragement, even under the guise of defending certain values. Who are the people who have fallen along the way in our lives, in our disagreements, battles, or simply because of the passage of time? With whom could we reconnect? How can we raise our sights?
