DEAN'S BIT – You may remember that I suggested that we make the Gospel accounts of the Resurrection appearances of Jesus part of our Easter prayer. This Sunday's Gospel, though not a Resurrection appearance, lends itself to prayerful reflection. In John 10.11-18, Jesus speaks of himself as the Good Shepherd. After you read the passage slowly two or three times with pauses in between or as you read the passage, it may help your prayer to imagine yourself being held in Jesus' arms and protected by him. Just stay with the image and with how it makes you feel. That could be all we need to do in prayer. Or we could ask the Shepherd what he wants to say to you. Sometimes prayer is just being with the Lord and that is enough.
