ARCHBISHOP'S PASTORAL LETTER ON VAD *It has been the constant teaching of the Catholic Church for the last two thousand years that no-one has the right to end their own life or to deliberately bring about the death of another, with the sole exception of the right of self-defence against an unjust aggressor. This conviction about the sanctity and inviolability of human life is one of the most foundational values by which we as Catholics live. We believe that every human life, from its earliest beginnings at conception to its final moments leading to death, is precious and sacrosanct. No-one has the right to "step in" and bring to an end a life that has begun under God's providence and will come to its end under God's providence. Please read the full pastoral letter. FR STAN SWAMY SJ - Our faith is a faith which does justice. Here is a brief glimpse into one life of faith and justice in the face of cruel injustice.

Fr Stan Swamy SJ passed away on 5 July 2021 in Holy Name Hospital in New Delhi aged 84. He fought hard for the land rights of Adivasi and Dalit communities against multi-national companies and mining businesses in India. He served as the director of the Indian Social Institute, a training school for marginalized communities in Bangalore, for more than a decade and was the co-founder of the Persecuted Prisoners Solidarity Committee, an organization assisting those held in prison while awaiting trial. Fr Stan was arrested by the National Investigation Agency of India on trumped-up charges about his advocacy work being linked to Maoist terrorism. His health deteriorated during his time in Mumbai's Talaja jail. His application for interim bail on medical grounds was rejected in October, after which he applied to the court to request a straw and a sipper because he was unable to hold a glass due to Parkinson's disease. The court eventually granted his request fifty days after his arrest. He remained in hospital in a critical condition after being tested positive for COVID-19 till his death. Fifteen other human rights activists remain imprisoned on the same charges and the campaign for their release continues. (jesuitmissions.org.uk & catholicnewsagency.com)
