The Holy Father launched the process on Saturday inviting the Church 'to listen to the Spirit in adoration and prayer, to listen to our brothers and sisters speak of their hopes and of the crises of faith present in different parts of the world, of the need for a renewed pastoral life and of the signals we are receiving from those on the ground.' Listening as truly being with?
