DEAN'S BIT I hope that many of you will come along to the book launch on 7 December. If you look around at the Cathedral and admire the art and architecture of the building, it is an event not to be missed.

The liturgical year comes to an end on Friday. Just as we have a calendar year, a financial year and sports calendars with their different seasons – cricket season, AFL season, etc. so we have a liturgical year with its seasons. The liturgical year is older than all the others and begins with Advent and ends with the week of the feast of Christ the King. It cycles through the significant seasons of the liturgy and during ordinary time it lays before us, through the Scriptures, the life and ministry of Jesus. It is an odd sort of cycle because it is a cycle which points beyond itself to an end point, the completion and fulfilment of all things when Christ will come again, the Omega point Ω of history. It is Christ the beginning and end who gives every moment its meaning and significance. This meaning is often hidden from our eyes as we walk by faith with love and hope, but the liturgical year teaches to look for Christ and his Spirit in our lives and in our world. He is present to us and to every moment. No moment is lost to him.
