**DEAN'S BIT** Please do keep our healthcare workers in your prayers for they are carrying on with their marvellous work in stressful circumstances; they are having to deal with those currently in their care as well as prepare for what is to come. Show your appreciation to them when we you can (we see some of them in the Cathedral) and keep them in your prayers. Teachers and education staff are other groups who are looking at February with some apprehension. They too need prayers and appreciation for the work they do is invaluable.

**HEALTH CARE OBLIGATION** The Holy Father has reaffirmed the church's teaching on health care and vaccination: 'Each of us has a responsibility to care for ourself and our health, and this translates into respect for the health of those around us. Health care is a moral obligation. Sadly, we are finding increasingly that we live in a world of strong ideological divides. Frequently people let themselves be influenced by the ideology of the moment, often bolstered by baseless information or poorly documented facts. Every ideological statement severs the bond of human reason with the objective reality of things. The pandemic, on the other hand, urges us to adopt a sort of "reality therapy" that makes us confront the problem head on and adopt suitable remedies to resolve it. Vaccines are not a magical means of healing, yet surely they represent, in addition to other treatments that need to be developed, the most reasonable solution for the prevention of the disease.'

CHILDREN'S LITURGY Respondents to the recent Cathedral Parish Council's 2021 survey revealed an interest in the Cathedral holding regular Children's' Liturgies.
