DEAN'S BIT At present government regulations do not require us to check the vaccination status of people coming to Mass though everyone is obliged to wear masks while in church. We have had enquiries from parishioners who are vulnerable to covid-19 because of their existing health conditions or who are caring for vulnerable people. We would not want parishioners to feel that they have to choose between participating in Mass and their own safety or of that of their loved ones. So I am thinking of designating one Mass every weekend for the fully vaccinated only. Everyone who wishes to come to that Mass would have to show proof of vaccination at the door. This may help anyone with the concerns above or anyone who wished to do so to come to a Mass at which they may feel safer. There would be limited or no singing at this Mass to reduce the risk even further. The other Cathedral Masses will of course remain open to everyone as usual. The Saturday 6pm Mass or the Sunday 8am Mass could be designated as the Mass for those who are fully vaccinated only. At this point I would ask for the opinion of parishioners. Do you have any concerns about participating in Mass at present. Do you have a preferred Mass time?

The other Masses will remain open to all unless there is some change in directions so you will be able to celebrate Mass at St Mary's whatever your vaccination status. We do, however, encourage everyone to get vaccinated.

EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS INCLUDING ACOLYTES In order to do all we can to keep parishioners safe, all extraordinary ministers including acolytes who are going to continue their ministry in the present circumstances will need to be fully vaccinated. If you are not vaccinated, would you please take a little break from ministry until the present health crisis is past. The Cathedral appreciates everyone's generosity and this break too is an act of generous service to your neighbour. The Cathedral is not checking vaccination certificates of ministers at this point.
