The Aboriginal Catholic Ministry of the Archdiocese of Perth is seeking to appoint a full time, permanent Pastoral Assistant. The successful applicant will have a strong awareness of Aboriginal culture, knowledge and understanding the effects of isolation, illness, death, and being "off country" for Aboriginal people and knowledge and understanding of human rights issues that impact on the lives of Aboriginal people.
