DEAN'S BIT So what happens now with Plenary Council motions? Those which were passed by two-thirds have become decrees. After the Australian bishops have their conference in November, the decrees are sent to Rome to receive the recognitio of the Holy See; once that is received, the decrees will be implemented and become law for the Australian church next year. Not all the decrees will become law, e.g. motion 4.5 which was passed by the required majorities: 'That, should the universal law of the Church be modified to authorise the diaconate for women, the Plenary Council recommends that the Australian Bishops receive this possibility and examine how best to implement it in the context of the Church in Australia.' This decree depends on the universal church making a change to law which would in turn depend on a certain development of teaching on Holy Orders. So this decree signalled an openness on the part of the Australian church, but does not affect universal law. Other decrees will become law if the recognitio is given, e.g. a decree that every diocese have a diocesan pastoral council. The next stage of the journey is crucial, the reception and implementation of the decrees of the Council.
