<u>**DEAN'S BIT**</u> One of the first issues the Plenary Council addressed was that of Reconciliation and one of its first decrees reads:

The Fifth Plenary Council endorses the Uluru Statement from the Heart and encourages engagement with processes for implementing the statement, including local, regional and national truth-telling efforts.

This was the fruit of the years-long discernment in which the Australian church had engaged leading up the Council. The Ulura Statement from the Heart was itself the work of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander delegates who gathered in May 2017 and who invited the country to created a better future through key reforms.

We call for the establishment of a First Nations Voice enshrined in the Constitution.

The St Vincent de Paul Society recently welcomed polling which shows strong support for a 'Yes' vote in a referendum on a First Nations Voice to Parliament for the Vinnies have been consistent in their support for 'enshrining a voice in the Constitution as advocated in the Uluru Statement from the Heart'. It seems to me that the Plenary Council is calling on all of us to engage positively with this process. Let's do so with a generous spirit.
