DEAN'S BIT On 13 October the Cathedral is hosting a multi-faith service on the urgent action needed to combat climate change (see below). I invite you to join us in prayer. Bishop Sproston will be representing the Archdiocese at the service. The Holy See has endorsed the call for a Fossil Fuel Non-Proliferation Treaty. Cardinal Czerny, Prefect of the Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development said that,

regarding COP27, Pope Francis again joins scientists in holding to the Paris Agreement's temperature increase goal of 1.5°C. The planet already is 1.2°C hotter, yet new fossil fuel projects every day accelerate our race towards the precipice. Enough is enough. All new exploration and production of coal, oil, and gas must immediately end, and existing production of fossil fuels must be urgently phased out. This must be a just transition for impacted workers into environmentally sound alternatives. The proposed Fossil Fuel Non-Proliferation Treaty holds great promise to complement and enhance the Paris Agreement

A few days ago a video was released featuring the Holy Father in conversation with four people; the participants hail from Senegal, the Amazon, India and Hawaii bringing 'perspective and solutions from the poor, the indigenous, the youth, and wildlife'.
