DEAN'S BIT All Hallows (All Saints) and All Souls have come round once more. They begin our November remembrance of our friends, loved ones and parishioners who have died. In *Spe Salvi*, Pope Benedict XVI wrote of purgatory: *The encounter with him is the decisive act of judgement. Before his gaze all falsehood melts away. This encounter with him, as it burns us, transforms and frees us, allowing us to become truly ourselves. All that we build during our lives can prove to be mere straw, pure bluster, and it collapses. Yet in the pain of this encounter, when the impurity and sickness of our lives become evident to us, there lies salvation. His gaze, the touch of his heart heals us through an undeniably painful transformation "as through fire". But it is a blessed pain, in which the holy power of his love sears through us like a flame, enabling us to become totally ourselves and thus totally of God.* This transformation does not occur in time as we experience it now, it cannot be measured in days, months, years, it eludes earthly time-reckoning—it is the heart's time, it is the time of "passage" to communion with God in the Body of Christ. Our prayers for the dead can play a small part in their journey of purification - ***It is never too late to touch the heart of another, nor is it ever in vain.***
