SAFEGUARDING REPORT On Saturday, October 29, Fr. Sean and four Safeguarding Officers (SGOs) evaluated the Cathedral Parish's conformity to the standards outlined by the Safeguarding Activities Assessment Tool 2022, an assessment process set by the National Catholic Safeguarding Standards. Upon appraisal, the SGOs concluded that a safeguarding culture with transparent governance has been established firmly in the various aspects of parish life. This earns the parish the highest conformance level. However, some areas of improvement were identified. The team recognised a possible weak link in the absence of information meetings with church workers, affecting the personnel's understanding and implementation of policies and procedures. The SGOs also deemed that further action is required for the promotion of safeguarding workshops. To address these concerns, the team recommended a more visible campaign for safeguarding information and courses in parish notices, at masses and by the SGOs themselves. Particular focus is also needed on community feedback and engagement. The team proposed to put a feedback box and a dedicated notice board in the Cathedral foyer.

The SGOs undertook a risk analysis on the physical and online setting of the Cathedral. They proposed that a sign "Children must be accompanied by an adult" be erected along the ramp leading to lavatories. Furthermore, guidelines must be created to ensure that church online users sign the existing acceptable internet use policy. Finally, the SGOs are ever more committed to the Archdiocese's safeguarding goals. Therefore, at the beginning of Sunday masses, such commitment will be reiterated and the presence of SGOs will be noted.
