ARE YOU BUYING ETHICAL CHOCOLATE THIS CHRISTMAS SEASON? Did you know that much of the chocolate available in Australia comes from cocoa beans picked by children, many of whom have been trafficked or forced to work in exploitative conditions? It is estimated that there are at least 800,000 children working in the cocoa industry at present: 5-10% of these have been trafficked. To ensure that the chocolate you buy has been produced in an ethical manner, look for the following labels: Fairtrade, Rainforest Alliance or UTZ.

PLEASE BEWARE OF SCAMS The Cathedral is aware that there have been emails sent to Parishioners that impersonate the Archbishop and Cathedral priests, either requesting for help or donations. With news of recent data breaches, it is a timely reminder to all Parishioners to be careful of such scams. If Parishioners wish to donate to the Cathedral's mission and homeless cause, please put your donation into a sealed envelope and place it into one of the donation boxes located at the entrance of the Cathedral. Never hand money directly to anyone claiming to be a staff or volunteer of the Cathedral. Please contact the Cathedral Office or Duty Guard immediately, if you have been approached by person(s) soliciting funds/donations on behalf of the Cathedral's cause.

MERCY CONNECT PERTH You can make a real difference to the life of a child who often feels isolated and anxious at school. With your willingness to form a strong relationship with a child and through your assistance to develop language skills, a refugee/migrant student is able to considerably improve his/her capacity to succeed at school and in the wider Australian community. As a volunteer for Mercy Connect, you are allocated a student, or a small group of students, and you assist at their primary or secondary school for half a day per week during school terms. Training is provided and commencement at a school is in February 2023.
