ASH WEDNESDAY AND LENT This Wednesday, 22 February, is Ash Wednesday which marks the beginning of the season of Lent. There is Mass with the imposition of ashes at the Cathedral at 8am, 12.10pm and 6pm; and at All Saints Chapel at 12:10pm.

Ash Wednesday is a day of abstinence and fasting. Abstinence in Catholic practice is to refrain from eating meat. Fasting means having only one full meal on a day. Smaller quantities of food may be eaten at two other meals but no food should be consumed at any other time during the day.

The law of fasting applies to people from 18 to 59 years old. Everyone aged 14 years and older is bound by the law of abstinence from meat.

There will be Stations of the Cross on Fridays of Lent at 5pm beginning on 3 March.

**UKRAINE** On Friday, 24 February at 6pm the Ukrainian Catholic Parish of St John the Baptist will hold an intercessory prayer service (Moleben) to the Mother of God in the Cathedral, to pray for the victims of war and the people of Ukraine. The date marks 365 days of resistance, courage and resilience, but also 365 days of prayer and support from all parts of the world. You are invited to attend and pray.
