DEAN'S BIT HAPPY EASTER! The Lord is risen indeed! I hope that your sense of Easter joy is deepened and enriched through your celebration of the Triduum in the Cathedral. The Risen Lord reaches out to console his disciples – to turn their sorrow into joy, to fill them with faith, hope and love. He does this to the people who denied and betrayed him such is his love. He does not dwell on the past with them reproachfully, taking the opportunity to make them feel guilty; he just lifts them up to share in his joy.
