DEAN'S BIT Hello, it has been a while since there has been space in the bulletin for something from me. In fact this bit is not from me as such, but from the Archbishop. The Archbishop would like to share with the Cathedral parish something from a letter which went out to the clergy recently: I am sure many of you would agree with me that we here in Perth have one of the most beautiful and architecturally innovative cathedrals in Australia. Every time I enter the cathedral, either to celebrate the liturgy or simply have some quiet moments in prayer, I am reminded of the great courage and vision of Archbishop Hickey and his many advisers in making the decision to undertake such a bold and extensive work of renovation.

In order to mark the programme of Liturgical and Eucharistic renewal at present underway in our archdiocese, and to highlight the Lord's wonderful gift of himself to us in the Eucharist, and after having discussed some possibilities with a number of people, I have commissioned some icons which I hope can be placed on the screen on either side of the tabernacle in the rear of the sanctuary. This area is meant to provide a reflective space for prayer before the Blessed Sacrament and it is my hope that the icons will add to this prayerful atmosphere....

The icons will gradually be installed as they are completed over the coming months. There will be seven in all. Above the tabernacle will be the traditional image of Christ Pantocrator (ruler of all). The other icons, three on each side of the tabernacle, will depict Mary the Mother of God, Saint John the Baptist, Saint Peter and Saint Paul, and St Benedict and St Mary of the Cross MacKillop.

I am looking forward to the installation of the icons and I hope you will as well. They will enhance the beauty of the Blessed Sacrament chapel and invite us to prayer. The screen lights will remain white to show them at their best.

NEXT SUNDAY 28 May 2023 we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost. At the 11am Mass the Archbishop will be confirming young members of our parish family. Please keep them in your prayers.
