MESSAGE FROM THE DEAN

The first assembly of the Synod will be taking place in the Vatican later this year and it may well be one of the most consequential events in the life of the Church since the Second Vatican Council! The working document of the Synod which brings together the fruits of the consultation of the people of God throughout the world is an extraordinary document. Our own Archbishop was on the body which drafted this document which is called the *Instrumentum Laboris*. This document will feed into the work of the first assembly; and Archbishop Costelloe has been named as one of the President-Delegates of the assembly which means that he will be one of those presiding over the assembly when the Holy Father is not present. The composition of the assembly is unprecedented; in the past the voting members - with a small number of exceptions - were bishops. This assembly still has a majority of bishops, but there are clergy and laypeople (men and women) who will vote as well. The breadth of the questions before them and the process they will undergo together is the first stage of two-year journey for the church. Please pray that they will listen to what the Spirit is saying to the church and that we shall be open to the Spirit's movement as well.
