**From the chair of the Parish Pastoral Council**

The Parish Pastoral Council's recent July 2023 meeting was a most interesting and energetic session with council members identifying and discussing strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats of the parish. Aided by an experienced external facilitator, the SWOT analysis proved a useful first exercise in the staged process towards developing and executing a strategic plan for the parish.

**Dean's bit**



The prayer *Adsumus Sancte Spiritus*, which is the incipit or first line of the prayer in Latin, is a prayer which bishops have used for hundreds of years as they gathered in council. It is attributed to the sixth century bishop, St Isidore of Seville. The version you see to the left, based on Isidore's original, has been written for the use of Catholics throughout the world as we journey toward the synod taking place in the Vatican later this year. We are invited to pray it with the synod participants and for the synod participants. The synod is not a parliament, it is members of the people of God joined together in a process of spiritual discernment with Peter and under Peter in the person of the Pope.

We are engaged in our own synodal journey as a diocese as preparations are underway for a diocesan assembly next year. One of the main tasks of the assembly is to help the Archbishop establish a diocesan pastoral council. There are already bodies which exist to assist the bishop like the Council of Priests and the College of Consultors, but these are bodies of priests. The diocesan pastoral council will have a wider membership. So as you pray the *Adsumus* please pray for our archdiocese as well.
