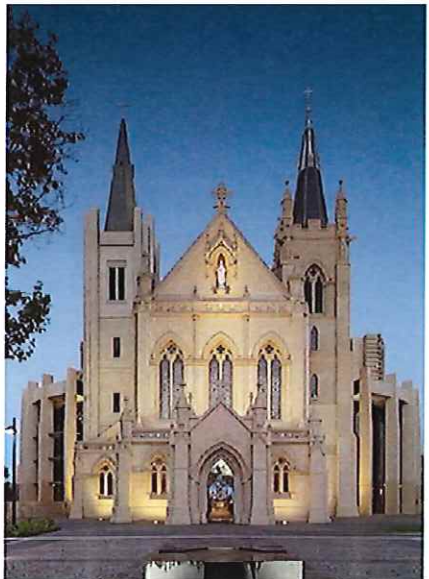

At WYD Pope Francis told the gathered young people that the church is for everyone, is for all. He got them to shout, 'all' a few times. It was a positive message. The church is a home for all, a community for all without distinction. Later the Holy Father was asked about this by a reporter and he reaffirmed that the church excludes no one and that each person encounters God in their own way inside the Church. What was important was for the church's ministers to accompany everyone with the patience and love of a mother. I think that the Pope's message is not just for us who have a ministry in the church, but for all the church's members. May we not exclude people, turn them away or make them feel unwelcome in our midst. May we walk gently with those who struggle with aspects of church teaching or life. Pope Francis has said often that time is greater than space. In other words, he writes, 'it is more important to start processes than to dominate spaces'. May the Spirit teach us this loving freedom.
