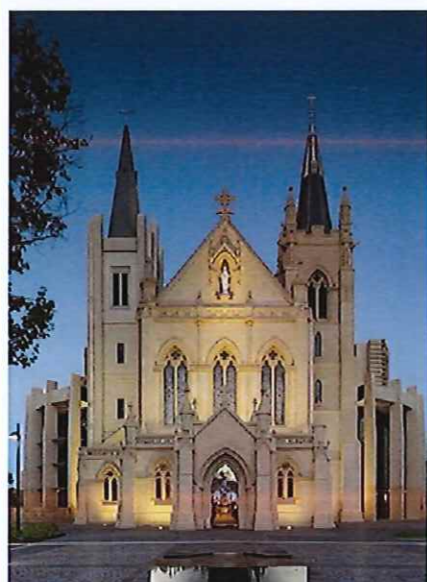

THE ICONS

at St Mary's Cathedral

The final four icons have now been hung either side of the Deisis. (Christ, Mary and John the Baptist) St Peter stands to the right of St John; his hand raised in blessing. In his other hand is a scroll reminding us of the scriptures. St Benedict of Nursia stands to the right of St Peter. His presence is a reminder of the Benedictine connection with the Cathedral. On his scroll is a quote from his Rule, "Listen and attend with the ear of your heart."

St Paul stands to the left of the Mother of God, holding a copy of the Scriptures. To his left stands St Mary of the Cross (Mackillop) who, unlike the other saints, looks out at us directly. Her invitation to us is that, "We must teach more by example than by word." This is a quote of hers from 1867.
