DEAN'S BIT

I am writing this bit on Thursday so before we know the results of the referendum. When you read this you will know the results or at least the trend. Whatever the result, we still have work ahead of us on the journey of reconciliation. The work and commitment do not end with the referendum whether the result is positive or negative. The church - so all of us - is committed to walking with the First Australians towards a more just society. The referendum has made us aware of woundedness and wounding behaviour in our community. Some positions were certainly principled and well-thought out on both sides, but some of the language betrayed barely-disguised prejudice. Peter Arndt, director of the bishops' Office of Justice, Ecology and Peace, wrote, a few days ago, 'Whatever the outcome of the referendum, it is our fervent hope that the commitment to a new engagement with First Nations Peoples will be embraced by all of us in the Church in the months and years ahead. One way or another, things must change for the better for Australia's First Peoples and for the whole country!' To that I hope we can all say, 'Amen!'
