CATHOLICS WHO SUFFER FOR WHAT IS RIGHT

There are Catholics who suffer because their faith makes them stand up for human rights. Two examples from different parts of the world: Bishop Rolando Álvarez of Matagalpa has been detained for more than a year by the Nicaraguan regime because of his advocacy. More recently another bishop and five priests were arrested by order of President Ortega. In Hong Kong Jimmy Lai, a prominent Catholic layman, is facing trial under draconian national security laws because he has championed press freedom. They and many other members of the body of Christ face persecution because of their stand for the democratic freedoms which we take for granted. Please keep them and all who suffer for their faith in your prayers.
