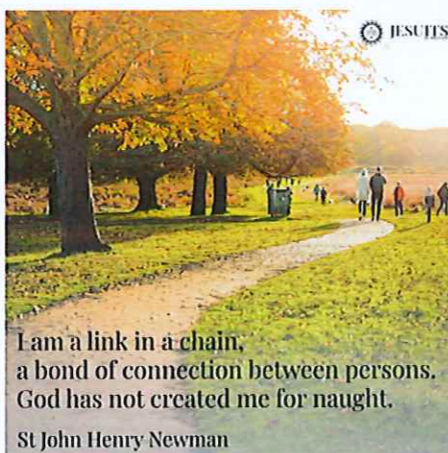

In parts of Nigeria, ongoing conflicts between communities, marked by threats to safety and security are all too common. Poverty, food insecurity, violent extremism, and tensions among ethnic groups have contributed to instability and violence. Beyond these challenges, our missionaries in Nigeria are facing fear and violence. In 2022 alone, four priests were killed and 28 were kidnapped. Amidst this danger, there are young seminarians who continue to answer their calling to priesthood and to peace. The tradition of the Church sees him as the 'ordinary', hidden, patient, creative, faithful man of mission who worked and sacrificed for the joy of loving something greater: Christ, our Redeemer, and Mary, the Mother of our Redeemer.
