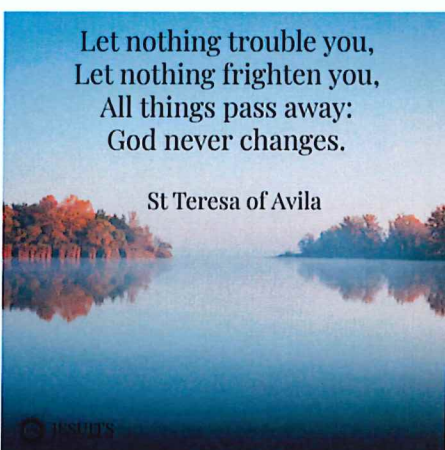

During the first weeks of Easter, we are celebrating baptisms within the Sunday Mass. Easter is a celebration Christ's death and resurrection for us. Baptism is our participation in Christ's death and resurrection. So celebrating baptism within our Easter Masses is a gift enabling us to rejoice in Christ's victory in the life of the child being baptised, in our own lives and the life of the whole church. Alleluia!
