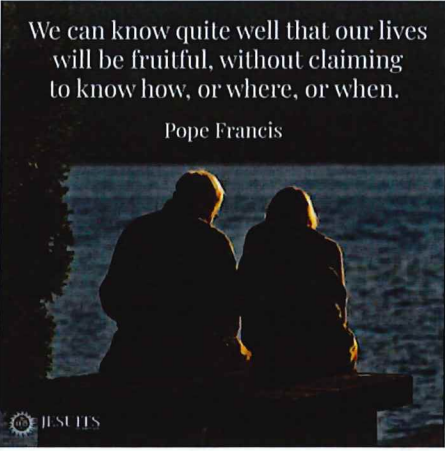

Dean's Bit

On Friday, 19 April, before a congregation which packed the Cathedral, two young men were ordained to the priesthood for the Archdiocese. It was a joyful event for the young men, Fr Errol Lobo and Fr Jason Yeap, for their families, friends and the whole archdiocese. Please keep them in your prayers as they begin their new ministry. It is an especially good day for us here because Fr Jason Yeap has been appointed an assistant priest at the Cathedral. We look forward to welcoming here and supporting him in his ministry. He will begin here towards the end of May.

This year the Archdiocese will be working with Australian Catholic Safeguarding Limited on the first audit which will review the Archdiocese's implementation of the National Catholic Safeguarding Standards.

The 10 National Catholic Safeguarding Standards incorporate recommendations from the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse and also the National Principles for Child Safe Organisations, contextualising these requirements for the Catholic Church in Australia.

Our Cathedral parish is one of the parishes which will be audited and I see this as an opportunity for us, as we work together to build a childsafe community together with the rest of the Archdiocese.
