DeaN's Bit

We do not know how the seeds planted today in our life or someone else's will bear fruit or indeed what fruit they will bear. I suppose the parents among us know this better than most. All they can do is plant seeds of love and faith in their children and hope.



We all play a role in sowing seeds - seeds of faith and love - in the lives of others. When we lift people up with our words and deeds - forgiveness, welcome, compassion - we are sowing seeds. We have no control over the growth, the flowering and, nor should we desire such control.

The journey of faith is different for each of us; it is a journey within the church certainly, but it is, above all, a journey in relationship with God who knows each one of us and is more patient than we.

As disciples we let everyone know that they are welcome to come on the journey of faith. There are no preconditions; they do not have to be any sort of person. We just walk the journey together trusting in God to lead each of us into his love and truth at God's pace and not mine or yours.



This is faith in God whose ways are not your ways and mine. Kosuke Koyama wrote of the "three mile an hour God" - God walks slowly with us because God is love.

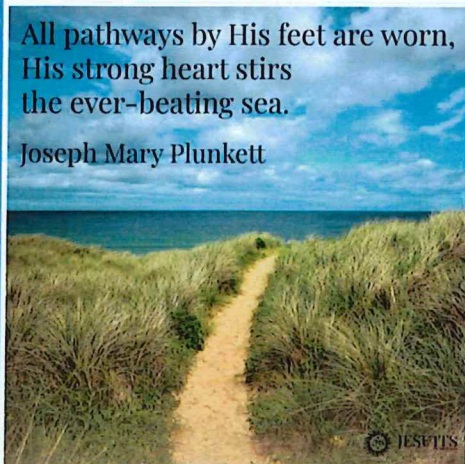
