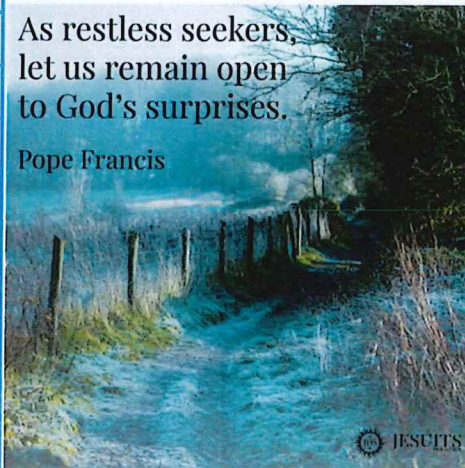

WELCOME



A warm welcome to the 5pm Mass to the delegates attending the Catholic School Principals Australia National Conference. We pray that during their time together they will 'learn, share, engage and help dream the future of Catholic Education'.

And another thing... If you follow the news, you will have seen stories - some of them heartrending - of families whose visa applications have been rejected because of a child with a disability. The Commonwealth's Migration Act is exempt from the Disability Discrimination Act. Do read that again. Is it not shocking? Migrants are subject to a Migration Health Requirement (MHR) and this is in itself not unreasonable, but, as recent submission to Home Affairs says 'the premise underlying Australia's MHR framework is an inherent, arbitrary assumption that people with disability or health conditions, and their families, are necessarily a net burden to our Australian society, rather than a net asset to our communities, schools and workplaces.' Treating people with disability as simply a burden on society is appalling. We, as a country, can do better. Let's pray and lobby that we do.
