

DeaN's Bit

Safeguarding Sunday is the way the church marks the end of National Child Protection Week. It is one day at the end of one week in the year, but it reminds us of a 24/7 commitment to safeguarding children and adults at risk. Protecting children is everyone's business. All of us have a part to play. This year's theme is 'Every conversation matters'. Conversations are powerful tools to keep children and young people safe and well. What conversations can you have which might help keep someone safe?

Last week the Cathedral Parish took part in a safeguarding audit by Australian Catholic Safeguarding Ltd. as part of an audit of the Archdiocese. ACSL has been created to promote and oversee a nationally consistent, comprehensive and sustainable framework for the protection of children and adults at risk within the Church in Australia. The audit is not of individual parishes, but of the whole diocese and will be published so that everyone can see how we are doing in meeting safeguarding standards and what we can do to improve.
