As I wrote last week, the Cathedral has taken part in a safeguarding audit. It is an audit of the whole archdiocese rather than of the Cathedral, but we welcomed the opportunity to participate. We want to know where we can improve. I'll let you know when the results are published.

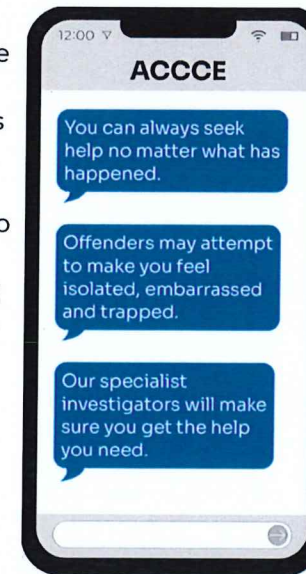
We showed the auditors the processes and structures we have in place to help us build a community which is safe for children and adults at risk. This includes the work done by our wonderful safeguarding officers, the comprehensive records which are maintained in the office of Working with Children checks, personal declarations, etc. You will know our security guards and may have noticed the new CCTV system in the Cathedral; there are also cameras around the house and office. We have a new sign-in system for ministers which incorporates a live check of their Working with Children card. There is new signage and are glass panels on office doors. The confessionals were re-designed a few years ago to enhance safety for all. There is a lot of work which has gone into making the Cathedral as safe as possible. But the commitment is ongoing; we need to keep working together to make our church as safe as possible. Thank you for the part you play.

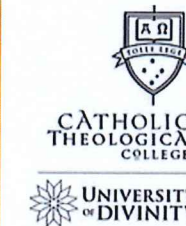
**Cathedral Choir – on the road !!**

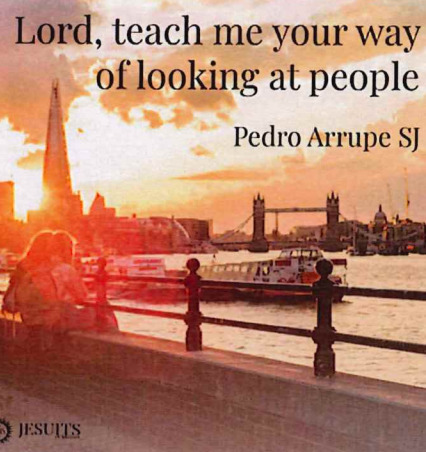
