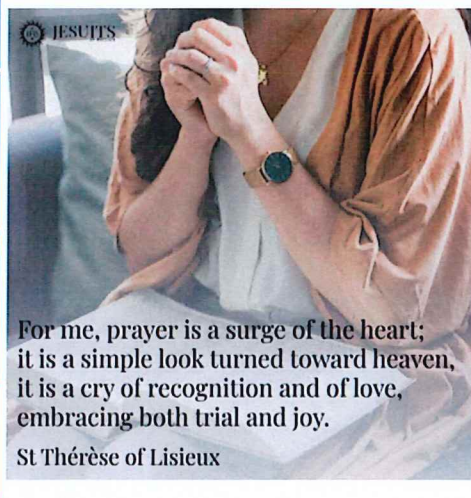
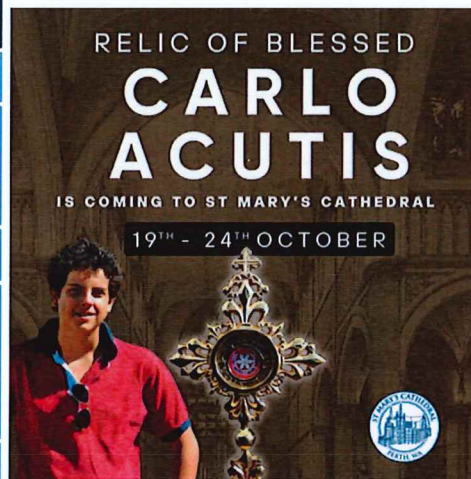

Carlo was a boy like any other, and at the same time, he did extraordinary things. Without apparent effort, without any contradiction. He played the saxophone and, still very young, taught catechism to children. He played soccer with his friends, and an hour later, he would be volunteering at the soup kitchen of the Capuchins and Mother Teresa's nuns for the poor. He had fun with video games, and at the same time, he used the internet to do apostolic works. He watched detective shows and made films with his dogs and cats, and he helped the less fortunate in the neighbourhood. He designed computer programs and helped other children with homework difficulties. Enlightened, animated by an extraordinary faith that he had lived deeply since childhood. This made him an example capable of involving and inspiring others to action.
